Section 286-102.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows: "(f) A provisional licensee may be issued a driver's 3 4 license in accordance with this chapter if the provisional licensee: 5 Has satisfactorily held a provisional license for at 6 (1) 7 least six months[+] or has attained the age of 8 eighteen, whichever comes first; 9 (2) Has no pending proceeding that might result in the 10 suspension or revocation of the license; 11 (3) Is at least seventeen years of age; and 12 Has satisfactorily complied with all requirements of (4) this chapter." 13 14 SECTION 2. Act 72, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is amended by amending section 15 to read as follows: 15 16 "SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect on January 9, 17 2006 [provided that on January 9, 2011, this Act shall be 18 repealed and sections 286 102, 286 104, 286 106, 286 108, 2010-2031 SB2449 CD1 SMA.doc
