BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291-59, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+]§291-59[+] Enforcement. (a) Notwithstanding any law
- 4 to the contrary, and in addition to any other authority provided
- 5 by law that is not inconsistent with the purposes of this part:
- 6 (1) A law enforcement officer may access the property of a
- 7 private entity to enforce the provisions of this part;
- 8 and
- 9 (2) A commissioned volunteer enforcement officer may
- 10 access the property of a private entity during normal
- 11 business hours of the entity to enforce the provisions
- of this part;
- 13 provided that the private entity's parking lot contains a
- 14 parking space reserved for persons with disabilities.
- 15 (b) Hawaii law enforcement officers in good standing,
- 16 whether on or off duty, may enforce traffic infractions under
- 17 this part."
