## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE FUND.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) In 1999, the legislature established the 2 emergency and budget reserve fund as a temporary supplemental 3 source of funding for the State of Hawaii in times of emergency, 4 economic downturn, or unforeseen reduction in revenues. As set forth in section 328L-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, specific 5 6 purposes for the fund include the maintaining of levels of 7 programs determined to be essential to public health, safety, 8 welfare, and education. 9 The legislature finds that the national and global 10 economic crisis has caused significant economic problems in 11 numerous industries in the state, including the airline, cruise **12** ship, tourist, and construction industries. Mass layoffs have 13 been reported by an increasing number of Hawaii businesses 14 statewide, from the agricultural sector to the medical services 15 sector. Hawaii's automobile dealers have cut fifteen per cent 16 of their workforce and that percentage could double in the

future. Financial uncertainty has caused decreased visitor

- 1 arrivals and low hotel occupancy rates leading to layoffs and
- 2 reductions in employee hours. Furthermore, recent forecasts
- 3 show that the situation will worsen with a continued decline in
- 4 jobs, personal income, and visitor arrivals, and with rising
- 5 inflation.
- 6 Difficult economic times and declining tax revenues have
- 7 resulted in budget cuts for all state services. State
- 8 departments have been asked to lower their budget proposals by
- 9 up to twenty per cent. The department of education faces a
- 10 possible \$100,000,000 shortfall for the next academic year and
- 11 funding has discontinued for science textbooks and materials,
- 12 programs for literacy training for learning-disabled children,
- 13 as well as for speech pathologists, occupational, and physical
- 14 therapists, and more than two hundred other positions.
- The department of health has projected a \$25,000,000
- 16 shortfall for mental health services in the current fiscal year.
- 17 Funding has been eliminated for the healthy start program,
- 18 totaling approximately \$22,000,000 for the biennium.
- 19 Additionally, the governor has discontinued funding for the
- 20 Hawaii children's health care program, which may leave an
- 21 estimated one thousand five hundred gap group children without
- 22 access to affordable health care.

(4)4 Within the emergency budget and reserve fund were (e) 5 enumerated purposes for which appropriations could be made as 6 well as specific prohibitions. Appropriations to maintain 7 levels of programs determined to be essential to the public 8 health, safety and welfare are allowed. 9 Appropriations for the following purposes are specifically **10** prohibited: 11 (1)To meet expenses of the legislature; 12 To provide for salary adjustments for officials (2) 13 appointed pursuant to article V, section 6 or article 14 VI, section 3 of the Constitution of the State of 15 Hawaii and for others whose salaries are directly 16 related to salaries of these officials; and 17 To fund cost items in any collective bargaining (3) 18 contract. 19 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys from (f) 20 the emergency and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii to 21 maintain the levels of programs determined to be essential to

education, public health, and public welfare.
