

# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO USE OF TOBACCO SETTLEMENT FUNDS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. To enable the John A. Burns school of medicine 1 to continue to operate and graduate new physicians, funding from 2 the tobacco settlement needs to continue. Act 264, Session Laws 3 of Hawaii 2007, contains a sunset date that will eliminate the 4 ability of the John A. Burns school of medicine to continue 5 6 receiving these funds. 7 The purpose of this Act is to continue the funding to the John A. Burns school of medicine until 2015. 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 328L, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 10 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 11 and to read as follows: "<u>§328L-</u> <u>Reporting.</u> The department of health and the 12 University of Hawaii shall prepare a detailed accounting of all 13 14 revenues and expenditures relating to: (1) Moneys appropriated to, and expended by, the 15

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department of health for purposes of section 328L-4;

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1	(2)	Moneys appropriated into, and expended from, the
2		Hawaii tobacco prevention and control trust fund under
3		section 328L-5;
4	<u>(3)</u>	Moneys appropriated into, and expended from, the
5		university revenue-undertakings fund created in
6		section 304A-2167.5; and
7	(4)	Any moneys used for the operating costs of the medical
8		school facility,
9	and shall	submit this information to the legislature no later
10	than thirty days after the close of each fiscal year."	
11	SECTION 3. Act 264, Session Laws Hawaii 2007, as amended	
12	by section 22 of Act 16, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, is amended	
13	by amending section 4 to read as follows:	
14	"SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007,	
15	and shall be repealed on June 30, [ <del>2011;</del> ] <u>2015;</u> provided that	
16	section 328L-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in	
17	the form in which it read on the day before the effective date	
18	of this Act."	
19	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed	
20	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.	
21	SECT:	ION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
