- 1 SECTION 1. Section 10-14.55, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+] §10-14.55[+] Audit and report. The auditor shall
- 4 conduct an audit of the office at least once every four years
- 5 and shall submit a report on findings and recommendations to the
- 6 governor and the legislature on or before the convening of the
- 7 next immediate legislative session. The first audit report
- 8 shall be submitted no later than January 15, 1996. The auditor
- 9 shall conduct a financial and management audit of the office,
- 10 and shall submit a report on findings and recommendations to the
- 11 governor and the legislature on or before the convening of the
- 12 2011 legislative session."
- 13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect up of its approval.
