RELATING TO ADMINISTRATIVE LICENSE REVOCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 291E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to part III to be appropriately
3	designate	d and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§29</u>	1E- Application procedures after lifetime
5	revocatio	n. (a) A respondent whose license has been revoked
6	for life	may apply for reinstatement of a license, in writing to
7	the direc	tor on a form provided by the director; provided that
8	the appli	cation shall:
9	(1)	Be made not sooner than fifteen years from the date of
10		issuance of the lifetime revocation by the
11		administrative driver's license revocation office;
12	(2)	Be accompanied by written proof that the respondent,
13		within the ninety days immediately preceding the date
14		the application is received by the administrative
15		driver's license revocation office, has been assessed
16		by a certified substance abuse counselor who has
17		determined that the respondent is not in need of
18		substance abuse treatment due to dependency or abuse
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1		under the applicable Diagnostic and Statistical Manual
2		and Addiction Severity Index or its successor;
3		provided that the assessment shall be submitted with
4		the application; and provided further that the costs
5		of the assessment shall be borne by the respondent;
6		and
7	(3)	The application shall be in a form of a sworn
8		statement approved by the director; provided that the
9		sworn statement shall contain information that
10		demonstrates that the respondent no longer poses a
11		real and serious danger to the safety and welfare of
12		the people of this State.
13	(b)	The application under subsection (a) shall be denied
14	if:	
15	(1)	The application does not meet all of the requirements
16		of subsection (a); and
17	(2)	After the issuance of the lifetime revocation, the
18		respondent has been arrested, convicted, or
19		adjudicated for any traffic infraction or a similar
20		infraction in another jurisdiction; provided that the
21		administrative driver's license revocation office may
22		retrieve and consider information available from any
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1	judiciary computer system, problem driver pointer
2	system or its successor system, national database
3	record or its successor, or similar federal, state, or
4	county database retrieval system that allows access by
5	authorized agencies.
6	(c) A respondent whose license has been revoked for a
7	lifetime more than once shall not be eligible to apply for a
8	reinstatement of the license.
9	(d) There shall be assessed a fee to process the
10	application for reinstatement of license in the amount of \$100."
11	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
12	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2011.
