BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 79, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is amended
- 2 by amending section 4 to read as follows:
- 3 "SECTION 4. The department of budget and finance is
- 4 authorized, from time to time, including times subsequent to
- 5 [June 30, 2010,] June 28, 2015, to issue special purpose revenue
- 6 bonds in whatever principal amounts the department shall
- 7 determine to be necessary to refund the special purpose revenue
- 8 bonds authorized in section 2 and to refund special purpose
- 9 revenue bonds authorized in this section, regardless of whether
- 10 the outstanding special purpose revenue bonds or refunding
- 11 special purpose revenue bonds have matured or are the subject of
- 12 redemption or whether the refunding special purpose revenue
- 13 bonds shall be bonds for the multi-project programs described in
- 14 section 2.
- 15 In making this determination, the department shall comply
- 16 with federal law relating to the exemption from federal income

- 1 taxation of the interest on bonds of the nature authorized by

- 5 "SECTION 5. The authorization to issue special purpose
- 6 revenue bonds under this Act shall lapse on [June 30, 2010.]
- 7 June 28, 2015."
