A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NET ZERO ENERGY CAPABLE NEW HOMES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Net zero energy capable design in new single
family residential construction means that the home is
sufficiently energy efficient so that it is cheaper to generate
on-site renewable energy than to further increase the efficiency
of the home.

6 The legislature finds that initiating a net zero energy 7 policy by 2015 will encourage the incorporation of on-site 8 residential renewable energy systems in the near term as well as 9 encourage a reduction in cost of these systems in the future. As a result of instituting a net zero energy policy, the 10 11 legislature anticipates reduced projected energy demand and 12 lower greenhouse gas emissions with minimal cost to the State 13 for developing the policy and ensuring compliance. Further, a 14 net zero energy policy promotes growth in the capacities for 15 energy efficiency and renewable energy in the development and 16 construction industries.



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1	SECTION 2. Chapter 196, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§196- Net zero capable construction. (a) By
5	January 1, 2015, all new single-family residential construction
6	shall be net zero capable.
7	(b) An individual who constructs a single-family residence
8	for use as the individual's own primary residence may apply to
9	the coordinator for an exemption from subsection (a), which the
10	coordinator shall grant if the individual shows, to the
11	satisfaction of the coordinator, that complying with subsection
12	(a) would be impractical or cost-prohibitive."
13	SECTION 3. Section 196-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14	amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
15	and to read as follows:
16	""Net zero capable" means the energy efficiency building
17	standards for single-family residential construction as
18	determined by the state building code council by December 31,
19	<u>2010.</u> "
20	SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
