1	SECTION 1. Section 612-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) A prospective juror is qualified to serve as a juror
4	if the prospective juror:
5	(1) Is a citizen of the United States and of the State;
6	(2) [Is] <u>Beginning January 1, 2010, is</u> at least eighteen,
7	but not more than seventy years old;
8	(3) Is a resident of the circuit; and
9	(4) Is able to read, speak, and understand the English
10	language."
11	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
12	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
13	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
