SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by adding a new section to article 10A to be 3 appropriately designated and to read as follows: 4 "§431:10A- Colon cancer screening coverage. (a) Each policy of accident and health or sickness insurance providing 5 6 coverage for health care, except for policies that only provide coverage for specified diseases or other limited benefit 7 coverage, shall provide coverage for colorectal-cancer screening 8 by all A and B grade screening modalities as recommended by the 9 10 United States Preventive Services Task Force. Beginning March 1, 2011, all health insurance 11 (b) providers in Hawaii shall inform their insured about the risk 12 associated with undiagnosed colorectal-cancer and encourage the 13 14 insured to consult with the insured's physician about available screening options." 15

SECTION 2. Chapter 432, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by adding a new section to part VI of article 1 to be 2 appropriately designated and to read as follows: 3 4 "§432:1- Colon cancer screening coverage.
