RELATING TO PUBLIC AGENCY MEETINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 92-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 3 "(e) The board shall maintain a list of names and
- 4 electronic and postal mail addresses of persons who request
- 5 notification of meetings and shall [mail] transmit a copy of the
- 6 notice to such persons at their last recorded electronic mail
- 7 address no later than the time the agenda is filed under
- 8 subsection (b). If no electronic mail address is listed, then
- 9 the copy of the notice shall be mailed to such persons at their
- 10 last recorded postal address no later than the time the agenda
- 11 is filed under subsection (b)."
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 92-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- "(b) The minutes shall be public records and shall be
- 15 available within thirty days after the meeting except where such
- 16 disclosure would be inconsistent with section 92-5; provided
- 17 that minutes of executive meetings may be withheld so long as

- their publication would defeat the lawful purpose of the 1
- 2 executive meeting, but no longer. Upon request, minutes that
- 3 have become public record may be electronically mailed to the
- requestor, or if the requestor does not have an electronic mail 4
- 5 address, then the minutes may be mailed to the requestor at the
- 6 requestor's last recorded postal address."
- 7 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
