10	(1)	Each position filled by a non-civil service, temporary
11		employee, the purpose of the position, and the date
12		that the position was established;
13	(2)	How long the position has been filled by a non-civil
14		service, temporary employee, and the reason the
15		position has not been filled by a permanent civil
16		service or exempt employee; and

1	(3)	In the case of any position that has been filled by	
2		the rehiring of a person for at least three contract	
3		periods in one fiscal year, the reasons for the	
4		rehiring and why the position should or should not be	
5		made permanent.	
6	For	the purposes of this section, "non-civil service,	
7	temporary	employee" means any person employed for a contract	
8	period of less than ninety days."
