BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

The director of finance is authorized to issue 2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$, or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year 4 5 2010-2011, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the fourteenth senatorial district, as follows: 6 7 1.
