## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by adding a new section to part III, subpart B, to be
appropriately designated and to read as follows:
"§302A- Department of education facilities and support
services branch; qualifications of administrator and project
managers. (a) The administrator of the department's facilities
and support services branch, at a minimum, shall possess
supervisory experience in the building and construction trades
commensurate with the responsibilities of a comparable
administrator of a facilities and support services agency. The
administrator of the department's facilities and support
services branch shall report to the assistant superintendent of
administrative services.
(b) Project managers of the department's facilities and
support services branch, at a minimum, shall possess project
management experience in the building and construction trades

commensurate with the responsibilities of a comparable project

    manager of a facilities and support services agency and shall be

    supervised by the administrator of the facilities and support

         SECTION 2. No officer or employee of the State having
 5
    tenure shall suffer any loss of salary, seniority, prior service
 6
    credit, vacation, sick leave, or other employee benefit or

    privilege as a consequence of this Act, and such officer or

    employee may be transferred or appointed to a civil service
9
    position without the necessity of examination; provided that the

    officer or employee possesses the minimum qualifications for the
11
    position to which the officer or employee was transferred or
12
    appointed; and provided that subsequent changes in status may be
13
    made pursuant to applicable civil service and compensation laws.

         An officer or employee of the State who does not have
15
    tenure and who may be transferred or appointed to a civil
16
    service position as a consequence of this Act shall become a

    civil service employee without the loss of salary, seniority,

    prior service credit, vacation, sick leave, or other employee

    benefits or privileges and without the necessity of examination;
