## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 103F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
designated and to read as follows:
"§103F- Medicaid contracts; healthcare insurance plan
contractors; reimbursements to home and community-based case
management agencies. (a) In any contract entered into with a
Medicaid healthcare insurance plan contractor that provides
reimbursement to home and community-based case management
agencies, the department of human services shall include
contract provisions that specify the duties and obligations of
the Medicaid healthcare insurance plan contractor to the home
and community-based case management agency, as follows:
(1) When renewing a policy with a home and community-based
case management agency, the Medicaid healthcare
insurance plan contractor shall not reduce
reimbursement rates to the home and community-based
case management agency in excess of per cent of

1		the reimbursement rates in effect under the expiring
2		policy with the home and community-based case
3		management agency;
4	(2)	Paragraph (1) shall not apply if the reduction in
5		reimbursement rates is necessary to ensure:
6		(A) Clients' access to, or choice of, a home and
7		community-based case management agency; or
8		(B) Prevention of a substantial and foreseeable risk
9		of harm to clients;
10		and
11	(3)	The Medicaid healthcare insurance plan contractor
12		shall not enter into, or renew, any policy with a home
13		and community-based case management agency unless the
14		policy contains maximum reimbursement levels for chore
15		services and non-emergency medical transportation.
16	<u>(b)</u>	As used in this section, the terms "client" and "home
17	and commu	nity-based case management agency" shall have the same
18	meanings	ascribed to them under section 346-331."

4	. (c) The department of human services shall submit a
5	request for review to the United States Department of
6	Agriculture regarding the proposed reorganization plan that
7	transfers services to an eligibility-processing operations
8	division to address possible concerns and determine potential
9	violations of federal regulations or policy.
10	(d) The task force shall submit a report of its findings
11	to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the
12	convening of the regular session of 2011.
13	PART III
14	SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
15	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
16	begun before its effective date.
17	SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
