- 9 invalid, the invalidity does not effect other provisions or
- 10 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
- 11 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 12 of this Act are severable.
- 13 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
