# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WITNESSES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 621-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: "(a) Every witness legally required to attend a state
- 4 court or grand jury in any criminal case, other than a public
- 5 officer or employee, shall be entitled to [\$20] \$55 for each
- 6 day's attendance and a reasonable mileage fee to be established
- 7 pursuant to rules adopted by the judiciary for each mile
- 8 actually and necessarily traveled on the ground each way,
- 9 including travel to and from the nearest airport when required
- $10\,$  to travel from another island or from outside the State. In
- 11 addition to witness' fees, every witness [-7] who attends a state
- 12 court from outside the State shall be entitled to the actual
- 13 round-trip cost of plane travel, plus [\$110 per twenty-four hour
- 14  $\frac{day_{\tau}}{day_{\tau}}$  \$160 for each day's attendance, or if from any island
- 15 other than that on which the court holds session, shall be
- 16 entitled to the actual round-trip cost of plane travel, plus \$55
- 17 [per twenty four hour day,] for each day's attendance, except

- 2 shall be entitled to an additional \$160 for each day's
- 3 attendance, which amounts shall cover all personal expenses,

- 6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 7 or so much
- 8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 and the
- 9 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- **10** 2010-2011 for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 12 of budget and finance for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009. SECTION 4.
