## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INSURANCE.

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## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding to part I of article 10A a new section to be
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:
4	"§431:10A-A Extension of dependent coverage. (a) A
5	health insurance plan issued by an accident and health or
6	sickness insurer shall make available, at the option of the
7	principal enrollee under the plan, coverage for any qualified
8	child, as defined in subsection (b), of the enrollee.
9	(b) The term "qualified child" means, with respect to a
10	principal enrollee in a health insurance plan, an individual
11	who, but for age, would be treated as a dependent child of the
12	enrollee under that plan and who is under twenty-seven years of
13	age and is not enrolled in another health insurance plan."
14	SECTION 2. Chapter 432:1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
15	amended by adding to part VI a new section to be appropriately
16	designated and to read as follows:
17	"§432:1-B Extension of dependent coverage. (a) A health

insurance plan issued by a mutual benefit society shall make

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- 1 available, at the option of the principal enrollee under the
- 2 plan, coverage for any qualified child, as defined in subsection
- 3 (b), of the enrollee.
- 4 (b) The term "qualified child" means, with respect to a
- 5 principal enrollee in a health insurance plan, an individual
- 6 who, but for age, would be treated as a dependent child of the
- 7 enrollee under that plan and who is under twenty-seven years of
- 8 age and is not enrolled in another health insurance plan."
- 9 SECTION 3. Section 432D-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 "§432D-23 Required provisions and benefits.
- 12 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, each
- 13 policy, contract, plan, or agreement issued in the State after
- 14 January 1, 1995, by health maintenance organizations pursuant to
- 15 this chapter, shall include benefits provided in sections
- 16 431:10-212, 431:10A-115, 431:10A-115.5, 431:10A-116,
- 17 431:10A-116.5, 431:10A-116.6, 431:10A-119, 431:10A-120,
- 18 431:10A-121, 431:10A-125, [and] 431:10A-126, and 431:10A-A, and
- **19** chapter 431M."
- 20 SECTION 4. In codifying the new sections added by sections
- 21 1 and 2 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute

- 1 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
- 2 the new sections in this Act.
- 3 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
