A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TOURISM EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 201B-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[+]\$201B-9[+] Tourism emergency. (a) If the board 4 determines that the occurrence of a world conflict, terrorist 5 threat, national or global economic crisis, natural disaster, 6 outbreak of disease, or other catastrophic event, regardless of 7 when or where it occurs, adversely affects Hawaii's tourism 8 industry by resulting in a substantial interruption in the 9 commerce of the State and adversely affecting the welfare of its **10** people, the board shall submit a request to the governor to 11 declare that a tourism emergency exists. **12** (b) Upon declaration by the governor that a tourism emergency exists pursuant to subsection (a), the authority shall develop and implement measures to respond to the tourism
- emergency exists pursuant to subsection (a), the authority shall develop and implement measures to respond to the tourism emergency, including providing assistance to tourists during the emergency; provided that any tourism emergency response measure implemented pursuant to this subsection shall not include any

- 1 provision that would adversely affect the organized labor force
- 2 in tourism-related industries. With respect to a national or
- 3 global economic crisis only, in addition to the governor's
- 4 declaration of the existence of a tourism emergency, no action
- 5 in response to the tourism emergency declaration may be taken by
- 6 the authority without the governor's express approval."
- 7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- $oldsymbol{8}$ and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2070.

Report Title:

Tourism Emergency; National or Global Economic Crisis

Description:

Adds a national or global economic crisis to situations considered a tourism emergency. Requires, in addition to the governor's declaration of the existence of a tourism emergency, the governor's express approval and direction before action may be taken. (SD2)
