## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAX ADMINISTRATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

The purpose of this Act is to provide for the 1 SECTION 1. 2 mandatory assessment of administrative costs associated with 3 investigating tax crimes where a taxpayer is convicted of a tax 4 offense. 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 231, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 6 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 7 and to read as follows: "§231- Criminal tax penalties; assessment for cost of 8 9 investigation. Any person who is convicted of an offense under section 231-34, 231-35, 231-36, or 231-36.4, in addition to any 10 11 other penalties provided by law, shall be assessed by the court 12 the reasonable cost of investigating the violation. 13 Any costs recovered under this section shall be deposited 14 into the tax administration special fund." SECTION 3. Section 235-20.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 15 16 amended to read as follows:
