BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§291C-</u> <u>Driving in right lane.</u> (a) A truck,
5	tractor-semitrailer combination, trailer, truck-tractor, or
6	truck-trailer combination, as those terms are defined in section
7	286-2, but not including a pickup truck, shall be driven on the
8	publicly maintained right lane of a highway and those private
9	streets as described in section 46-16, having two or more lanes
10	in the same direction with a posted speed limit equal to or
11	greater than forty-five miles per hour.
12	(b) This section shall not apply to a driver who is:
13	(1) Preparing for a left-hand turn;
14	(2) Yielding to an emergency vehicle;
15	(3) Moving around a stalled vehicle or other obstacle in
16	the right lane; or

1	(4) Overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in
2	the same right lane.
3	(c) The penalty for violation of this section shall be as
4	provided in section 291C-161."
