## A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE XI, SECTION 8 OF THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION, TO PROHIBIT THE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW PETROLEUM, COAL, AND NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS IN THE STATE WITHOUT THE PRIOR APPROVAL OF TWO-THIRDS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
2	amendment to article XI, section 8 of the Constitution of the
3	State of Hawaii to prohibit the construction of new petroleum,
4	coal, or nuclear power plants within the State without the prior
5	approval of two-thirds of the house of representatives and of
6	the senate.
7	SECTION 2. Article XI, section 8, of the Constitution of
8	the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows:
9	"[ <del>NUCLEAR</del> ] ENERGY <u>SECURITY</u>
10	Section 8. For the benefit of present and future

6	SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
7	be as follows:

10	petroleum, coal, or nuclear power plants within the State be
11	prohibited except when prior approval of two-thirds of each
12	house of the legislature is obtained?"
13	SECTION 4. Constitutional material to be repealed is
14	bracketed and stricken. New constitutional material is
15	underscored.
16	SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
17	compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
18	the State of Hawaii.
