BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 196, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§196- Use of motion sensor technology in hotel rooms.
5	(a) No building permit shall be issued for any new
6	construction, major renovation, or retrofit of an existing
7	building of a hotel that does not include the use of motion
8	sensor technology in the hotel rooms.
9	(b) For the purpose of this section:
10	"Major renovation" means any significant altering in any
11	way of one or more facilities or structural components of a
12	hotel facility; and
13	"Motion sensor technology" means technology that uses
14	motion sensor devices or other technology to automatically
15	control a building's lighting, heating, ventilation, and air
16	conditioning systems based on the presence or absence of
17	people."
