## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 196, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§196- Use of motion sensor technology in state
- 5 **facilities.** (a) No building permit shall be issued for any new
- 6 construction, major renovation, or retrofit of a facility that
- 7 does not include the use of motion sensor technology.
- 8 (b) The department of accounting and general services
- 9 shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 to implement this
- 10 section.
- 11 (c) For the purpose of this section:
- 12 "Major renovation" means any significant altering in any
- 13 way of one or more facilities or structural components of a
- 14 facility; and
- 15 "Motion sensor technology" means technology that uses
- 16 motion sensor devices or other technology to automatically
- 17 control a building's lighting, heating, ventilation, and air
