21	of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as of that date.

1	SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
2	projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
3	designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act, as
4	follows:
5	(1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 18 shall be
6	expended by the department of education; and
7	(2) The sums appropriated in items 19 through 21 shall be
8	expended by the department of transportation.
9	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
