# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF  
THE SIXTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much  
thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2010-2011  
for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the  
sixteenth senatorial district, as follows:

SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as of that date.





1       SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital  
2 projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the  
3 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act, as  
4 follows:

5       (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 18 shall be  
6       expended by the department of education; and

7       (2) The sums appropriated in items 19 through 21 shall be  
8       expended by the department of transportation.

9       SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
