BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1	. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated			
3	and to read as follows:			
4	" <u>§</u> 30	2A-	Searchable budget database. (a) The	
5	department of education shall develop, maintain, and make			
6	available to the public, at no cost, a searchable budget			
7	database website that shall contain the following information:			
8	(1)	The	amount and source of all moneys received by the	
9		depa	rtment when the amount is at least \$5,000;	
10	(2)	Mone	ys expended by the department in an amount of at	
11		<u>leas</u>	t \$1,000, including:	
12		<u>(A)</u>	The name and principal location or address of the	
13		`	entity receiving moneys; except that information	
14			concerning a payment to an employee of the	
15			department shall identify the individual employee	
16			by position and business address only;	
17		(B)	The amount of expended moneys;	

1	<u>(C)</u>	the funding source of the expended moneys;		
. 2	<u>(D)</u>	The name of the budget program or activity		
3		receiving the moneys; and		
4	<u>(E)</u>	A description of the planned use of the moneys		
5		for fiscal year 2010-2011 and each fiscal year		
6		thereafter.		
7	(b) The	financial data shall be provided in a structured		
8	format that may be downloaded. The budget database website			
9	shall include	a method by which a website user may provide		
10	feedback conce	rning the organization or utility of the website.		
11	(c) The	budget database website shall be made publicly		
12	available no later than July 1, 2011, and shall contain only			
13	information that is public record or that is not confidential or			
14	otherwise protected from public disclosure pursuant to state or			
15	federal law.			
16	(d) To t	he extent practicable, the department shall update		
17	the financial	data contained on the website monthly. The		
18	department sha	ll archive the financial data, which shall remain		
19	accessible and	searchable for a minimum of five years.		
20	(e) For	the purposes of this section, "entity" means a		
21	corporation, a	ssociation, union, limited liability company,		
22	limited liability partnership, grantee, contractor, local			
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- 1 government, or other legal entity including a nonprofit
- 2 corporation, and does not include an individual recipient of
- 3 state public assistance or public assistance provided by the
- 4 department of education."
- 5 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
