A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is				
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated				
3	and to read as follows:				
4	" <u>§302</u>	2A	Searchable budget database. (a) The department		
5	of educati	on sh	nall develop, maintain, and make available to the		
6	public, at no cost, a searchable budget database website that				
7	shall contain the following information:				
8	(1)	The a	amount and source of all moneys received by the		
9		depar	etment when the amount is at least \$5,000;		
10	(2)	Money	vs expended by the department in an amount of at		
11		least	\$1,000, including:		
12		(A)	The name and principal location or address of the		
13			entity receiving moneys; except that information		
14			concerning a payment to an employee of the		
15			department shall identify the individual employee		
16			by position and business address only; provided		
17			that, in accordance with section 92F-12(a)(14),		

1		salary costs of employees shall be disclosed as			
2		ranges of salary, rather than specific salaries;			
3	<u>(B)</u>	The amount of expended moneys;			
4	<u>(C)</u>	The funding source of the expended moneys; and			
5	<u>(D)</u>	The name of the budget program or activity			
6		receiving the moneys.			
7	(b) The	financial data shall be updated semi-annually and			
8	provided in a	structured format that may be downloaded. The			
9	department sha	ll archive the financial data, which shall remain			
10	accessible and	searchable for a minimum of five years. The			
11	budget database website shall include a method by which a				
12	website user may provide feedback concerning the organization or				
13	utility of the	website.			
14	(c) The	budget database website shall be made publicly			
15	available no later than July 1, 2011, and shall contain only				
16	information that is public record or that is not confidential or				
17	otherwise protected from public disclosure pursuant to state or				
18	federal law.				
19	(d) To t	he extent feasible, the department shall implement			
20	the searchable	budget database and the requirements of this			
21	section as are financially practicable; provided that if the

1 appropriation needed to completely carry out the purposes of 2 this section in one fiscal year, then the department may 3 establish and implement the searchable budget database in 4 phases; provided further that the initial phase of the 5 searchable budget database shall be completed and implemented no 6 later than July 1, 2011. 7 (e) For the purposes of this section, "entity" means a 8 corporation, association, union, limited liability company, 9 limited liability partnership, grantee, contractor, local **10** government, or other legal entity including a nonprofit 11 corporation, and does not include an individual recipient of **12** state public assistance or public assistance provided by the 13 department of education." 14 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
