
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 132D-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

 "\$132D-17 [Inconsistent county] County ordinances, rules.
- 4 (a) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, no county
- 5 shall enact ordinances or adopt any rules regulating fireworks
- 6 or articles pyrotechnic[, except as required in this chapter,]
- 7 that [is inconsistent with or more] are less restrictive than[7]
- 8 the provisions of this chapter. Any county may enact ordinances
- 9 or adopt any rules under chapter 91 regulating fireworks or
- 10 articles pyrotechnic that are more restrictive than the
- 11 provisions of this chapter.
- 12 (b) Any ordinances and rules regulating fireworks or
- 13 articles pyrotechnic that were enacted or adopted by a county
- 14 before March 31, 1995, except those provisions [which] that are
- 15 [not inconsistent with, or] more restrictive than those of this
- 16 chapter, are declared void."
- 17 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
