### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC ORDER.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 711-1100, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended as follows: 3 By adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted 4 and to read: 5 ""Primary pet enclosure" means any kennel, cage, or 6 structure used to restrict an animal to a limited area of 7 space." 8 By amending the definition of "necessary sustenance" to 9 read: 10 ""Necessary sustenance" means care sufficient to preserve 11 the health and well-being of a pet animal, except for 12 emergencies or circumstances beyond the reasonable control of 13 the owner or caretaker of the pet animal, and includes but is 14 not limited to the following requirements: 15 (1)Food of sufficient quantity and quality to allow for 16 normal growth or maintenance of body weight; 17 (2)Open or adequate access to water in sufficient

6.	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
7	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
8	begun before its effective date.
9	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
