6 The regents candidate advisory council shall be selected in 7 a wholly nonpartisan manner. If any member has not been 8 appointed within one hundred eighty days of May 1, 2007, the sitting members on the regents candidate advisory council shall 9 10 make an interim_appointment to fill the vacant seat. The 11 interim appointee shall satisfy the requirements for appointment 12 provided in this subsection and shall serve until the time when 13 the appropriate appointing authority makes an appointment for 14 the vacant seat as provided in this subsection. Appointees to 15 the regents candidate advisory council shall have a general 16 understanding of the purposes of higher education, the mission 17 of the University of Hawaii system, and the responsibilities of 18 the board of regents. Appointees shall be individuals who are 19 widely viewed as having placed the broad public interest ahead 20 of special interests, having achieved a high level of prominence 21 in their respective professions, and being respected members of 22 the community."
