A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 328L-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsections (a), (b), and (c) to read as
follows:
"(a) There is established in the state treasury the
emergency and budget reserve fund which shall be a special fund
administered by the director of finance, into which shall be
deposited:
(1) Moneys received from the tobacco settlement moneys
under section 328L-2; [and]
(2) Appropriations made by the legislature to the fund $[-]_{i}$
and
(3) Five per cent of the state general fund balance at the
close of the fiscal year, whenever state general fund
revenues for each of two successive fiscal years
exceeds revenues for each of the preceding fiscal
years by five per cent, pursuant to article VII,
section of the Hawaii Constitution. For the

1	purpose of this section, the general fund balance at
2	the close of the fiscal year shall be calculated
3	before any tax refund or tax credit is authorized by
4	the legislature, pursuant to article VII, section 6 of
5	the Hawaii Constitution, that is provided during the
6	same regular session as the transfer depositing such
7	moneys to the emergency and budget reserve fund;
8	provided that transfers shall not be made to the
9	emergency and budget reserve fund whenever the balance
10	of the emergency and budget reserve fund is equal to
11	or more than ten per cent of general fund revenues for
12	the preceding fiscal year. The transfer shall be
13	executed by the director of finance;
14	provided that all moneys deposited into the emergency and budget
15	reserve fund under paragraphs (1) and (2) and all moneys
16	deposited under paragraph (3) shall be kept in separate and

18	(b) All interest earned from moneys in the emergency and

1 State during times of emergency, severe economic downturn, or 2 unforeseen reduction in revenues. No expenditures shall be made 3 from the emergency and budget reserve fund except pursuant to 4 appropriations. The general appropriations bill or the 5 supplemental appropriations bill, as defined in section 9 of 6 article VII of the Hawaii Constitution [of the State of Hawaii], 7 shall not be used to appropriate moneys from the emergency and budget reserve fund. The governor, through an appropriations 8 9 bill, may recommend expenditures from the emergency and budget 10 reserve fund by setting forth the purposes of the expenditures 11 consistent with subsection (d), the amounts, and the reasons 12 justifying the necessity for the appropriations." 13 SECTION 2. Act 119, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, is 14 amended by amending section 6 to read as follows: 15 "SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009, 16 and shall be repealed on June 30, 2015; provided that section 17 328L-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in the form 18 in which it read on the day before the effective date of Act 19 264, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007 [-]; provided further that section 328L-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in 20 21 the form in which it read on the day before the effective date 22 of this Act."

1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020, and 4 upon ratification of a constitutional amendment requiring the 5 deposit of excess revenues from the general fund into the 6 emergency and budget reserve fund; provided that the amendments 7 made to section 328L-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, by section 1 of 8 this Act shall not be repealed when section 328L-3, Hawaii 9 Revised Statutes, is reenacted on June 30, 2015, pursuant to 10 section 6 of Act 119, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009.

Report Title:

Emergency and Budget Reserve Fund; General Fund Balance

Description:

Allows moneys from the excess general fund balance to be deposited into the emergency and budget reserve fund as a temporary source of funding for the State during times of emergency, severe economic downturn, and unforeseen reduction in revenues. Requires that moneys transferred from the general fund and other moneys in the emergency and budget reserve fund be kept in separate accounts. Effective July 1, 2020. (SB2806 HD1)
