# A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE VII, SECTION 6, OF THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION, RELATING TO THE TAX REBATE REQUIREMENT.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
2	amendment to article VII, section 6, of the Hawaii Constitution
3	to amend the requirement that excess general fund revenues be
4	returned to taxpayers of the State as a tax refund or tax credit
5	and allow the legislature to deposit these excess revenues into
6	one or more funds, as provided by law, to serve as temporary
7	sources of funding for the State in times of an emergency,
8	economic downturn, or unforeseen reduction in revenue.
9	SECTION 2. Article VII, section 6, of the Hawaii
10	Constitution is amended to read as follows:
11	"DISPOSITION OF EXCESS REVENUES
12	Section 6. Whenever the state general fund balance at the
13	close of each of two successive fiscal years exceeds five
14	percent of general fund revenues for each of the two fiscal
15	years, the legislature in the next regular session shall provide
16	for a tax refund or tax credit to the taxpayers of the State, $\underline{or}$
17	make a deposit into one or more funds, as provided by law, which

1	shall serve as temporary supplemental sources of funding for the
2	State in times of an emergency, economic downturn, or unforeseen
3	reduction in revenue, as provided by law."
4	SECTION 3. The question printed on the ballot shall be as
5	follows:
6	"Shall the legislature be provided with the choice, when
7	the state general fund balance at the close of each of two
8	successive fiscal years exceeds five per cent of the
9	general fund revenues for each of the two fiscal years, to
10	provide a tax refund or tax credit to the taxpayers of the
11	State, or to make a deposit into one or more funds, as
12	provided by law, which shall serve as temporary
13	supplemental sources of funding for the State in times of
14	an emergency, economic downturn, or unforeseen reduction in
15	revenue?"
16	SECTION 4. New constitutional material is underscored.
17	SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
18	compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Hawaii
19	Constitution.
