## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TARO.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 211, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, section
- 2 2, is amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:
- "(e) The task force shall submit a preliminary report to
- 4 the legislature documenting the status of its progress no later
- 5 than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session
- 6 of 2009. The task force shall submit a final report to the
- 7 legislature summarizing its program, the results achieved,
- 8 actual expenditures, and recommended legislation no later than
- 9 twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of
- 10 [<del>2010.</del>] <u>2012.</u>"
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 to achieve
- 14 the objectives of the taro security and purity task force
- 15 pursuant to Act 211, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008.
- 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of
- 17 Hawaiian affairs for the purposes of this Act; provided that no

- 1 funds shall be expended unless matched on a dollar for dollar
- 2 basis by the office of Hawaiian affairs.
- 3 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
