## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOURISM AUTHORITY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 201B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§201B- Budget; legislative approval; maximum
- 5 expenditure limits. (a) Notwithstanding sections 26-35 and
- 6 201B-5, the Hawaii tourism authority shall submit its budget
- 7 annually to the legislature for approval at least twenty days
- 8 prior to the convening of each regular session.
- 9 (b) The authority budget shall include a maximum
- 10 expenditure limit on programs and activities relating to:
- 11 (1) Marketing;
- 12 (2) Product development; and
- (3) Administration.
- 14 Upon approval of the authority budget by the legislature, the
- 15 authority may adjust actual annual expenditures within each of
- 16 the three operational categories listed in paragraphs (1), (2),
- 17 and (3), but actual annual expenditures within each of the
- 18 operational categories may not exceed the respective maximum

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- 1 expenditure limit for each operational category approved by the
- 2 legislature."

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- 3 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

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### Report Title:

Hawaii Tourism Authority; Budget; Submit to Legislature

### Description:

Requires Hawaii tourism authority to submit annual budget to legislature for approval. Requires expenditure caps on marketing, product development, and administration. Allows adjustment within each of the 3 categories, but not to exceed approved respective maximum expenditure limits.
