A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TORTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 663-10.98, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) Any other law to the contrary notwithstanding,
- 4 including but not limited to sections 663-10.9, 663-11 to
- 5 663-13, 663-16, 663-17, and 663-31, in any case involving tort
- 6 claims relating to the design, construction, and maintenance of
- 7 highways, where a design professional is determined to be a
- 8 joint tortfeasor along with one or more other joint tortfeasors,
- 9 and the degree of negligence of the design professional is ten
- 10 per cent or less, including the vicarious liability of the
- 11 design professional for the negligent acts or omissions of the
- 12 officers and employees of the design professional, the liability
- 13 of the design professional for more than the design
- 14 professional's pro rata share of negligence shall not exceed the
- 15 available policy limits of the design professional's
- 16 professional liability coverage; provided that one of the
- 17 following applies:

18	663-10.9."	
19	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that	
20	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were	
21	begun before its effective date.
