## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LICENSING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 448E-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

10		of experience in residential or commercial wiring of
11		at least five years full-time or its equivalent, but
12		not less than [10,000] ten thousand hours [of
13		experience], in the trade under the supervision of a
14		journey worker or supervising electrician [+];
15	(2)	Journey worker specialty electrician[. Every
16		applicant to]: To be eligible for the journey worker
17		specialty electrician examination, an applicant shall

3	(6)	Master plumber[. Every applicant to]: To be eligible
4		for the master plumber examination, an applicant shall
5		have been registered with the board as a journey
6		worker plumber for at least two years or shall have
7		[had] equivalent experience in the trade[-];
8	(7)	Maintenance electrician[. Every applicant to]: To be
9		eligible for the maintenance electrician examination,
10		an applicant shall be not less than eighteen years of
11		age and shall [have had] provide satisfactory evidence
12		of at least one year of experience in performing
13		electrical maintenance work or [proof of] two years of
14		schooling in the electrical trade[-];
15	(8)	Journey worker industrial electrician[. Every
16		applicant to]: To be eligible for the journey worker
17		industrial electrician examination, an applicant shall
18		be at least eighteen years of age and shall [have had]
19		provide satisfactory evidence of experience in
20		industrial electrical work of at least five years
21		full-time or its equivalent, but not less than
22		[10,000] ten thousand hours[-];

1	(9)	Supervising industrial electrician [. Every applicant
2		to]: To be eligible for the supervising industrial
3		electrician examination, an applicant shall have been
4		registered with the board as a journey worker
5		industrial electrician for a period of at least four

8	(b)	Effective July 1, 2013, an applicant for licensing
9	pursuant.	to this chapter shall possess the following minimum
10	qualifica	tions:
11	(1)	Journey worker electrician: To be eligible for the
12		journey worker electrician examination, an applicant
13		shall be at least eighteen years of age and shall
14		provide satisfactory evidence of:
15		(A) Experience in residential or commercial wiring of
16		at least five years full-time or its equivalent,
17		but not less than ten thousand hours, in the
18		trade under the supervision of a journey worker
19		or supervising electrician; and
20		(B) Satisfactory completion, accepted by a University
21		of Hawaii community college offering an

1			appropriate program of study, of two hundred
2			forty hours of electrical academic coursework;
3	(2)	Jour	ney worker specialty electrician: To be eligible
4		for	the journey worker specialty electrician
5		exam	ination, an applicant shall be at least eighteen
6		year	s of age and shall provide satisfactory evidence
7		of:	
8		<u>(A)</u>	Experience of at least three years full-time or
9			its equivalent, but not less than six thousand
10			hours, in the trade under the supervision of a
11			journey worker electrician, supervising
12			electrician, journey worker specialty

16			of Hawaii community college offering an
17			appropriate program of study, of one hundred
18			twenty hours of electrical academic coursework;

21		shal	l have been registered with the board as a journey

1		worker electrician for at least a period of four years
2		or shall have equivalent experience in the trade;
3	(4)	Supervising specialty electrician: To be eligible for
4		the supervising specialty electrician examination, an
5		applicant shall have been registered with the board as
6		a journey worker specialty electrician for at least a
7		period of two years or shall have equivalent
8		experience in the trade;
9	(5)	Journey worker plumber: To be eligible for the
10		journey worker plumber examination, an applicant shall
11		provide satisfactory evidence of experience of at
12		least five years' full-time or its equivalent, but not
13		less than ten thousand hours, as a journey worker's or
14		master plumber's helper;
15	(6)	Master plumber: To be eligible for the master plumber
16		examination, an applicant shall have been registered
17		with the board as a journey worker plumber for at
18		least two years or shall have equivalent experience in
19		the trade;
20	(7)	Maintenance electrician: To be eligible for the
21		maintenance electrician examination, an applicant

1		shal	l be not less than eighteen years of age and shall
2		prov	ide satisfactory evidence of:
3		(A)	At least one year of experience in performing
4			electrical maintenance work plus satisfactory
5			completion, accepted by a University of Hawaii
6			community college offering an appropriate program
7			of study, of at least eighty hours of electrical
8			academic coursework; or
9		<u>(B)</u>	Two years of schooling in the electrical trade
10			with not less than one thousand hours of hands-on
11			lab exercises;
12	(8)	Jour	ney worker industrial electrician: To be eligible
13		for	the journey worker industrial electrician
14		exam	ination, an applicant shall be at least eighteen
15		year	s of age and shall provide satisfactory evidence
16		of:	
17		(A)	Experience in industrial electrical work of at
18			least four years full-time or its equivalent, but
19			not less than eight thousand hours; and
20		(B)	Satisfactory completion, as accepted by a
21			University of Hawaii community college offering

1		an appropriate program of study, of two hundred
2	·	hours of electrical academic coursework;
3		and ·
4	<u>(9)</u>	Supervising industrial electrician: To be eligible
5		for the supervising industrial electrician
6		examination, an applicant shall have been registered
7		with the board as a journey worker industrial
8		electrician for a period of at least three years or
9		shall have equivalent experience in the trade."
10	SECT	ION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
11	matured,	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
12	begun bef	ore its effective date.
13	SECT	ION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
14	and stric	ken. New statutory material is underscored.
15	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
