## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC ORDER.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§711- Confinement of a dog by tethering; violation.		
5	(1) Except as provided in section 711-1109(1)(g), a person		
6	commits the offense of confinement of a dog by tethering if the		
7	person intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly tethers, fastens,		
8	ties, or restrains a dog to a doghouse, tree, fence, or any		
9	other stationary object or to a cable trolley system:		
10	(a) By a tether or chain that is less than five times the		
11	length of the dog, measured from the tip of its nose		
12	to the base of its tail, provided that, in no case,		
13	shall the tether or chain be less than ten feet in		
14	<pre>length;</pre>		
15	(b) By a tether or chain that weighs more than ten per		
16	cent of the weight of the dog tethered;		
17	(c) By a tether or chain that does not have a swivel on at		
18	least one end;		



1	<u>(d)</u>	By a tether or chain that allows the dog to reach	
2		within five feet of the property line; or	
3	<u>(e)</u>	Where the dog is under the age of six months.	
4	(2)	Confinement of a dog by tethering shall be a	
5	violation	; provided that any person convicted under this section	
6	shall be	sentenced as follows:	
7	<u>(a)</u>	For a first offense, by a fine of not less than \$50	
8		nor more than \$150, without the possibility of	
9		suspension; and	
10	<u>(b)</u>	For a second or subsequent offense, by a fine of not	
11		less than \$200 nor more than \$500, without the	
12		possibility of suspension."	
13	SECT	ION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that	
14	matured,	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were	
15	begun before its effective date.		
16	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
17	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		
18	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
