BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 606, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§606- Certified shorthand reporter; administration of
- 5 oaths or affirmations. Every certified shorthand reporter has
- 6 the power to administer oaths or affirmations and may perform
- 7 the duties of the deposition officer pursuant to rule 28(a) of
- 8 the Hawaii rules of civil procedure, relating to persons before
- 9 whom depositions may be taken."
- 10 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
