- 1 SECTION 7. Cost adjustments provided in this Act for any
- 2 officer or employee whose compensation is paid, in whole or in
- 3 part, from federal, special, or other funds shall be paid wholly
- 4 or proportionately, as the case may be, from the respective
- 5 funds.
- 6 SECTION 8. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act
- 7 for fiscal year 2009-2010 that are not expended or encumbered by
- 8 September 30, 2010, and for fiscal year 2010-2011 that are not
- 9 expended or encumbered by June 30, 2011, shall lapse as of those
- 10 dates.
- 11 SECTION 9. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
