## A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE I, SECTION 23, OF THE HAWAII STATE CONSTITUTION TO SPECIFICALLY RESERVE MARRIAGE TO OPPOSITE-SEX COUPLES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an 2 amendment to article I, section 23, of the Constitution of the 3. State of Hawaii to specifically reserve marriage to opposite-sex 4 couples as provided by law. SECTION 2. Article 1, section 23, of the Constitution of 5 the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows: 6 7 "MARRIAGE 8 Section 23. [The legislature shall have the power to 9 reserve marriage to opposite-sex couples.] Marriage shall be 10 specifically reserved to opposite-sex couples as provided by 11 law." 12 The question to be printed on the ballot shall SECTION 3. 13 be as follows: 14 "Shall the state constitution be amended to specifically reserve marriage to opposite-sex couples?" 15
