#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 701-108, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended as follows:

  1. By amending subsection (1) to read:
- "(1) A prosecution for murder, murder in the first and second degrees, attempted murder, and attempted murder in the first and second degrees, criminal conspiracy to commit murder in any degree, [and] criminal solicitation to commit murder in any degree, and child sexual abuse as defined by section 588-2
- 10 2. By amending subsection (6) to read:

may be commenced at any time."

- "(6) The period of limitation does not run:
- During any time when the accused is continuously

  absent from the State or has no reasonably

  ascertainable place of abode or work within the State,

  but in no case shall this provision extend the period

  of limitation by more than four years from the

  expiration of the period of limitation prescribed in

  subsection (2); or
