BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 286-81, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

3	. "§28	6-81 Motorcycle, motor scooter, etc.; protective
4	devices.	(a) No person shall:
5	(1)	Operate a motorcycle or motor scooter, on any highway
6		in the State unless the person and any passenger the
7		person carries on the motorcycle or motor scooter
8		wears:
9		(A) Safety glasses, goggles, or a face shield, in the
10		case of a motorcycle or motor scooter that is not
11		equipped with windscreens or windshields; and
12		(B) [Any] A safety helmet and any other protective
13		devices[, other than a safety helmet,] required
14		by rules adopted by the director.
15		For the purpose of meeting the requirements of this
16		paragraph, a required device shall meet the
17		specifications and requirements established by rules
18		adopted by the director;

2		person unless the person furnishes:
3		(A) Safety glasses, goggles, or a face shield, in the

6		(B) [Any] A safety helmet and other protective

19	(3)	Sell or offer for sale or furnish any safety helmet,
20		safety glasses, goggles, face shield, windscreen,
21		windshield, or other protective devices represented to
22		meet the requirements of this part unless the device

1	meets the specifications and requirements established
2	by rules adopted by the director.
3	(b) No person [less than eighteen years of age] shall
4	operate or ride as a passenger on a motorcycle or motor scooter
5	on any highway in the State unless the person wears a safety
6	helmet securely fastened with a chin strap.
7	[(c) A safety helmet shall not be required for any person
8	who operates or rides as a passenger on a motorcycle or motor
9	scooter; provided that the motorcycle or motor scooter:
10	(1) Has three wheels;
11	(2) Is powered by an electric motor;
12	(3) Has a full body enclosed cab; and
13	(4) Has a seat belt assembly or a child restraint system
14	for the driver and passenger;
15	and the operator and passenger uses the seat belt or child
16	restraint system pursuant to sections 291 11.5 and 291 11.6.] "
17	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
18	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
19	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
