## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ESCROW DEPOSITORIES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 449-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "§449-5 License required to act as escrow depository. (a)
4 No person shall act as an escrow depository in this State unless
5 [it-is a corporation] licensed to do so by the commissioner.

6 [No person subject to the provisions of this chapter not

7 licensed-or exempted under this chapter shall transact any

8 business under any name, title or descriptive term which

9 contains the words "escrow", "escrow depository" or any other

10 word or phrase having the same or similar meaning.]

11 (b) No person shall act from an out-of-state location as 12 an escrow depository as to property located in this State 13 without obtaining a license from the commissioner. A violation

14 of this section shall be deemed an unlawful and deceptive trade 15 practice."
