# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SUPERINTENDENT OF EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
  amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
  and to read as follows:

  "S302A- Superintendent of education; appointment. (a)

  The superintendent of education shall be nominated and, by and

which shall be headed by an elected policy-making board to be 1 known as the board of education. The board shall have power in 2 3 accordance with law to formulate statewide educational policy, 4 adopt student performance standards and assessment models, and 5 monitor school success [, and to appoint the superintendent of 6 education as the chief executive officer of the public school 7 system]. The board [ $\frac{\text{shall appoint}}{\text{and}}$ ] may remove[ $\frac{1}{7}$ ] the 8 9 superintendent by a majority vote of its members. 10 superintendent[+ 11 (1) May be appointed without regard to the state residency provisions of section 78-1(b); 12 13 (2) May be appointed for a term of up to four years; and (3) May may be terminated only for cause." 14 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon the 17 ratification of a constitutional amendment to Article X, section 18

3, of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii that repeals the
