19	capital p	rojects set forth in section 1	shall be expended by the
20	designate	d expending agency for the pur	poses of this Act as
21	follows:		

1 .	(1)	For items 1 through 14, the expending agency shall be
2		the department of education;
3	(2)	For item 15, the expending agency shall be the
4		department of human services;
5	(3)	For item 16, the expending agency shall be the
6		department of health;
7	(4)	For item 17, the expending agency shall be the
8		department of land and natural resources; and
9	(5)	For item 18, the expending agency shall be the
10		department of transportation.
11	SECT	TION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
