### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the task force on 2 reinventing government was established in 2009 to examine the
- 3 current operations and organization of state government and make
- 4 recommendations on making state government more efficient. The
- 5 task force found that the department of education's existing
- 6 governance and organizational structure is unwieldly and lacks
- 7 accountability. The task force submitted a final report to the
- $oldsymbol{8}$  legislature that included a recommendation to restructure the
- 9 department of education into two major divisions, based on line
- 10 and staff functions, and to establish two senior deputy
- 11 superintendent positions one in charge of primarily academic
- 12 achievement-related functions, and the other responsible for
- 13 primarily administrative functions.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to implement the recommendation
- 15 of the task force on reinventing government to restructure the
- 16 department of education and establish two senior deputy
- 17 superintendent positions.

1	SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding two new sections to part IV to be
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:
4	"§302A- Duties of senior deputy superintendent for
5	academic achievement. The senior deputy superintendent for
6	academic achievement shall assume administrative responsibility
7	for all duties and functions assigned to the academic
8	achievement division. The specific duties and responsibilities
9	of the senior deputy superintendent for academic achievement
10	shall be established by the board, in consultation with the
11	superintendent. The senior deputy superintendent for academic
12	achievement shall report directly to the superintendent of
13	education and shall be evaluated on criteria established by the
14	board; provided that the evaluation criteria relate primarily to
15	improvements in student achievement.
16	§302A- Duties of senior deputy superintendent for
17	administration. The senior deputy superintendent for
18	administration shall assume administrative responsibility for
19	all duties and functions assigned to the administration
20	division. The specific duties and responsibilities of the
21	senior deputy superintendent for administration shall be
22	established by the board, in consultation with the

2	administra	ation shall report directly to the superintendent of
3	education	and shall be evaluated on criteria established by the
4	board; pro	ovided that the evaluation criteria relate primarily to
5	the qualit	ty of support services provided to teachers,

7	SECT	ION 3. Section 84-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8	amended by	amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
9	"(C)	The following persons shall file annually with the
10	state eth	ics commission a disclosure of financial interests:
11	(1)	The governor, the lieutenant governor, the members of
12		the legislature, and delegates to the constitutional
13		convention; provided that delegates to the
14		constitutional convention shall only be required to
15		file initial disclosures;
16	(2)	The directors and their deputies, the division chiefs,
17		the executive directors and the executive secretaries
18		and their deputies, the purchasing agents and the
19		fiscal officers, regardless of the titles by which the
20		foregoing persons are designated, of every state
21		agency and department.

1	(3)	The permanent emproyees of the registature and its
2		service agencies, other than persons employed in
3		clerical, secretarial, or similar positions;
4	(4)	The administrative director of the State, and the
5		assistants in the office of the governor and the
6		lieutenant governor, other than persons employed in
7		clerical, secretarial, or similar positions;
8	(5)	The hearings officers of every state agency and
9		department;
10	(6)	The president, the vice presidents, assistant vice
11		presidents, the chancellors, and the provosts of the
12		University of Hawaii and its community colleges;
13	(7)	The superintendent, senior deputy superintendents, the
14		deputy superintendent, the assistant superintendents,
15		the complex area superintendents, the state librarian,
16		and the deputy state librarian of the department of
17		education;
18	(8)	The administrative director and the deputy director of
19		the courts;
20	(9)	The members of every state board or commission whose
21		original terms of office are for periods exceeding one
22		year and whose functions are not solely advisory;

(10)	candidates for state elective offices, including	
•	candidates for election to the constitutional	
	convention, provided that candidates shall only be	
	required to file initial disclosures; and	
(11)	The administrator and assistant administrator of the	
	office of Hawaiian affairs."	
SECTION 4. Section 302A-101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
amended by adding two new definitions to be appropriately		
inserted and to read as follows:		
""Academic achievement division" means the academic		
achievement division of the department of education, established		
under section 302A-1102.		
"Administration division" means the administration divisio		
of the department of education, established under section		
302A-1102."

- 9 (a) There shall be a principal executive department to be known
- 10 as the department of education, which shall be headed by an
- 11 elected policy-making board to be known as the board of
- 12 education. The board shall have power in accordance with law to
- 13 formulate statewide educational policy, adopt student
- 14 performance standards and assessment models, monitor school
- 15 success, [and to] appoint the superintendent of education as the
- 16 chief executive officer of the public school system [-], and
- 17 delegate the duties and functions of the department to the
- 18 academic achievement and administration divisions, pursuant to
- 19 section 302A-1102.
- 20 (b) The board shall appoint, and may remove, the
- 21 superintendent by a majority vote of its members. The
- 22 superintendent:

1	(1) May be appointed without regard to the state residency		
2	provisions of section 78-1(b);		
.3	(2) May be appointed for a term of up to four years; and		
4	(3) May be terminated only for cause.		
5	(c) The superintendent of education shall appoint, and may		
6	remove, two senior deputy superintendents who shall be known		
7	respectively as the senior deputy superintendent for academic		
8	achievement and the senior deputy superintendent for		
9	administration. Each senior deputy superintendent may be		
10	appointed for a term of up to four years and may be terminated		
11	only for cause. The senior deputy superintendents shall not be		
12	subject to chapter 76.		
13	$[\frac{(c)}{(d)}]$ The board shall invite the senior military		
14	commander in Hawaii to appoint a nonvoting military

- 3 SECTION 8. Section 302A-1111, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 5 "(a) Under policies established by the board, the
- 6 superintendent shall be designated as the chief executive
- 7 officer of the public school system having jurisdiction over the
- 8 internal organization, operation, and management of the public
- 9 school system, as provided by law; and shall administer programs
- 10 of education and public instruction throughout the State,
- 11 including education at the preschool, primary, and secondary
- 12 school levels, and such other programs as may be established by
- 13 law.
- 14 The superintendent shall advise the board in the board's
- 15 delegation of the duties and functions of the department to the
- 16 academic achievement and administration divisions, pursuant to
- 17 section 302A-1102."
- 18 SECTION 9. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
