A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LEGISLATURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so 3 much thereof as may be necessary, for defraying any and all 4 session and nonsession expenses of the senate up to and 5 including June 30, 2010, including the 2009 regular session, 6 twenty-fifth legislature of the State of Hawaii, and pre-session 7 expenses and the expenses of any committee or committees 8 established during the interim between the 2009 and 2010 regular 9 sessions.

10 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by 11 the senate.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for defraying any and all session and nonsession expenses of the house of representatives up to and including June 30, 2010, including the 2009 regular session, twenty-fifth legislature of the State of Hawaii, and

pre-session expenses and the expenses of any committee or
committees established during the interim between the 2009 and
2010 regular sessions.

4 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by5 the house of representatives.

6 SECTION 3. Payment of expenses of the senate during the 7 interim between the 2009 and 2010 regular sessions shall be made 8 only with the approval of the president of the senate, and 9 payment of expenses of the house of representatives during the 10 interim between the 2009 and 2010 sessions shall be made only 11 with the approval of the speaker of the house of 12 representatives.

SECTION 4. Before January 20, 2010, the senate and the house of representatives shall each have their accounts audited and a full report of the respective audits shall be presented to the senate and to the house of representatives convening on January 20, 2010.

18 SECTION 5. Unless otherwise prescribed by law, the 19 expenses of any member of the legislature while traveling abroad 20 on official business of the legislature shall be \$130 a day as 21 authorized by the president of the senate and the speaker of the 22 house of representatives, respectively.

9	during fiscal year 2009-2010 to be deposited into the audit					
10	revolving fund established pursuant to section 23-3.6, Hawaii					
11	Revised Statutes.					
12	SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the audit					
13	revolving fund the sum of \$, or so much thereof as may					
14	be necessary, to the office of the auditor during fiscal year					
15	2009-2010, for the auditor to conduct or complete its audit					
16	functions as provided by law.					
17	The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by					
18	the auditor.					
19	SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the general					
20	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \qquad , or so

3	The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by				
4	the legislative reference bureau.				
5	SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the general				
6	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so				
7	much thereof as may be necessary, to the office of the ombudsman				
8	for defraying the expenses of the office during fiscal year				
9	2009-2010.				
10	The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by				
11	the ombudsman.				
12	SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the general				
13	revenues of the State of Hawaii the following sums, or so much				
14	thereof as may be necessary, for defraying the expenses of the				
15	legislative information system:				
16	(1) \$ to the senate; and				
17	(2) \$ to the house of representatives.				
18	This appropriation shall be used to pay for hardware, software,				
19	consultant, installation, material, supply, and other related				
20	costs associated with the legislative information system that				
21	have been or will be incurred.				



1	SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the general
2	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of $\$$, or so
3	much thereof as may be necessary, for the legislative broadcast
4	program, including the production and distribution of television
5	broadcasts of legislative proceedings.
6	The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
7	the legislature for the purposes of this section.
8	SECTION 13. Except for moneys in the audit revolving fund,
9	as of the close of business on June 30, 2010, the unexpended or
10	unencumbered balance of any appropriation made by this Act shall
11	lapse into the general fund.
12	SECTION 14. Each section of this Act is declared to be
13	severable from the remainder of this Act.
14	SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
