- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) The driver of a vehicle involved in an accident
- 4 resulting in injury or death of any person or total damage to
- 5 all property to an apparent extent of \$3,000 or more shall
- 6 immediately by the quickest means of communication give notice
- 7 of the accident to the nearest police office. If sent to the
- 8 site of the accident, a responding police officer or other law
- 9 <u>enforcement officer</u> shall file a written report if it appears at
- 10 the time that the accident has resulted in the injury or death
- 11 of any person, or total damage to all property to an apparent
- 12 extent of \$3,000 or more."

Statewide Traffic Code; Notice of Accident

## Description:

Authorizes other law enforcement officers, in addition to police officers, to file a written report of an accident resulting in injury or death to a person or \$3,000 or more in property damages.
