### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMES AGAINST UNBORN CHILDREN.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by 2 adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read 3 as follows: 4 "CHAPTER UNBORN VICTIMS OF VIOLENCE ACT 5 6 S -1 Definitions. As used in this Act: "Unborn child" means the unborn offspring of a human being 7 from conception until birth, but not yet completely born. 8 9 "Without lawful justification" means acting under 10 circumstances in which the use of lethal force is not legally 11 justified. 12 § -2 Murder of an unborn child. (a) A person who causes 13 the death of an unborn child is guilty of murder of an unborn 14 child if the person, who is not the unborn child's mother, and 15 without lawful justification:
- 16 (1) Intends to cause the death of or do great bodily harm
  17 to the unborn child, or knows that the acts will cause

- 9 § -7 Exceptions. This chapter does not apply to:
  - (1) Acts which cause the death of an unborn child if those acts were committed during a legal abortion to which the pregnant woman consented; or
  - (2) Acts which are committed pursuant to usual and customary standards of medical practice during diagnostic testing or therapeutic treatment.
  - § -8 Other convictions not barred. A prosecution or conviction under this chapter is not a bar to conviction of or punishment for any other crime committed by the defendant as part of the same conduct."
- 20 SECTION 2. If any provision of this Act, or the
  21 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
  22 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
